

1910: I26 85-101MM AUJV, Rich&Lex&New
Recent/Upcoming Milestones: Segment 1 (8 lane section): March 11th switching EB traffic onto new concrete. March 18th switching WB traffic onto new concrete. This will be completing phase 2 and starting phase 3 in segment 1. Segment 2 (6 lane section): March 17th switching WB traffic onto temporary widening to begin median work. Mt. Vernon Road: Opening April 15th.



1912: I26 Widening FUAJV, Buncombe&Henderson
Recent Milestones: Switched WB Traffic onto new French Broad River Phase 2 Bridge
Upcoming Milestones: Shifting Traffic onto new permanent concrete from Airport Road to Blue Ridge Parkway. Completing Phase 2 Precast Segmental Bridge at Blue Ridge Parkway and Starting EB Bridge Construction

2005: BridgeWay Station, Greenville
Recent Milestones: Bent 2 and Bent 4 Columns Completed, Span 1 and Span 4 Barrier Rail Completed
Upcoming Milestones: Complete Bent 3 Precast, Complete concrete plaza area, Complete steel railing on Span 2 and Span 3



2007: US 1 over Altamaha River, Toombs
Recent Milestones: We opened both Southbound lanes to traffic on 12/16/22. One Northbound lane has been paved and the second lane is currently being paved. All bridge work has been complete for several months.
Upcoming Milestones: Opening all lanes to traffic and completing the project.

2016: US 521 over Pig Pine Tree Creek, Kershaw
Recent Milestones: Drilled Shafts in stage 2 were completed last week.
Upcoming Milestones: Stage 2 Pile Works and Interior Substructure will be completed in next few weeks.



2017: Alligator Road, Florence
Recent Milestones: Bridge 2 was Completed in late January. UD Completed the Demo of the existing I95 Bridge last week.
Upcoming Milestones: Stage 2 Drilled Shafts are expected to be completed in 5 Weeks.

2101: I77 Interchange, UBJV, York
Recent Milestones: Completed all approach slabs and MSE walls in January. Not much grading work lately due to weather.
Upcoming Milestones: Substantial Completion on 5/1/23



2115: I95 Widening FUJV, Lumberton
Recent Milestones: From Mile 22 to Mile 20 traffic has been shifted and barrier wall has been set.
Upcoming Milestones: Mid-March all of South Bound will be shifted in with Barrier set. Feb 23 Y4 Carthage Road will be shut down for new Bridge Construction

2208: Berlin G Myers Parkway, Dorchester
Recent Milestones: Pile Caps at Bents 4 & 5 of Bridge 1 have been poured, All pile driving was recently completed at Bridge 2 by Napoleon Utsey and his crew

Upcoming Milestones: Junior Singleton and his crew will pour Pile Caps at Bents 2 & 3 to complete Bridge 1 Pile Caps. Next will be forming for the concrete deck pours

·Napoleon Utsey and his crew will prepare to mobilize to Bridge 3 for Pile Driving efforts and to Bridge 4 for the Test Drilled Shaft Installation



2209: US 301 Over S. Edisto, Bamberg-Orangeburg
Recent Milestones: Configuring the MOT devices per the MOT Phase 2 plan. Building of two median crossovers both North and South of the Southbound bridge designated to be demolished, in order to accommodate the flow of commuters traveling Southbound on US 301.
Upcoming Milestones: The installation of drill shafts in the US 301 River following the lifting of an environmental moratorium set in place to accommodate the migration of Atlantic Sturgeon through the water-way. Once construction activities can resume we will be well on our way to finishing up major scopes of work and starting to wrap project up.

2117: S-831 over Socee Swamp, Williamsburg
Recent Milestones: The in-contract utility work was completed in January 2023. The Bridge was completed in October 2022.

Upcoming Milestones: The project is expected to be completed in May 2023.
